The figures above include the modelled element and the remaining windfall (based on the trend set out in Approach 1 in the SHLAA ) as per Approach 3 in the SHLAA report.

Where a borough's overall Approach 1 figure is more than the modelled approach plus remaining trend, the overall trend figure (i.e. Approach 1) is used (again as per Approach 3 the SHLAA report). The lower the % growth figure used, the more boroughs revert to trend figures. Grey boxes indicate where Approach 1 figures are used.

In Conservation Areas the growth rate assumption is reduced by 0.75%. For example a growth rate of 0.25% applies to Conservation Areas when the overall growth rate is 1%, but if using 0.5% overall growth rate, the Conservation Area rate will be 0.125%. Columns K-L provide the 12 year trend figure (as per Approach 2 in the SHLAA) with an uplift of 25% (column L) and 50% (column M).
